

Externally Sponsored Research (ESR): Application Submission Process

Regeneron is dedicated to supporting externally sponsored research that advances the medical and scientific knowledge related to Regeneron's products and therapeutic areas of interest.



Such research may enhance the understanding of our products and their potential applications, improve patient care, address critical scientific and clinical questions, and inspire new avenues for disease-related research.

Types of eligible Externally Sponsored Research (ESR):

1. Investigator Initiated Studies:

Independent, unsolicited research in which the external investigator conceives the research, develops the protocol, and serves as the **Sponsor**.

2. Research Collaboration:

Jointly defined research conducted in collaboration with an external researcher. Although Regeneron participates in the collaboration, the external researcher continues to serve as the **Sponsor**.

Support may be requested as drug supply and/or funding, provided it is reasonable and appropriate for the proposed study.

Please note the submissions falling into below categories must be directed to the appropriate portals:

1. Qualified third-party researchers seeking access to individual patient or aggregate level data from a Regeneron sponsored clinical study can submit a research proposal at <https://vivli.org/>.
2. Preclinical studies involving proprietary animal models, cell lines, or other technologies are excluded. For such studies, refer to the Regeneron Preclinical Research Collaborations Portal.

Application Submission & Review Process

1 Create Account



- ✓ Upon creating an account, please verify your account using the automatically generated email.

2 Log into your account and complete the online application form



- ✓ Upload all required documentation (such as W-8/W-9 forms and a Curriculum Vitae) into the 'Files' tab.
- ✓ Submit the finalized application for Regeneron review.

3 All submitted applications go through a two-stage review process by a cross-functional team:



Concept Review

- ✓ A Concept provides a concise overview of your proposal and must include enough detail for Regeneron to assess its potential interest to the program.
- ✓ **If the Concept is determined to be of interest, Regeneron will request a Full Protocol, including the detailed budget (if applicable).**

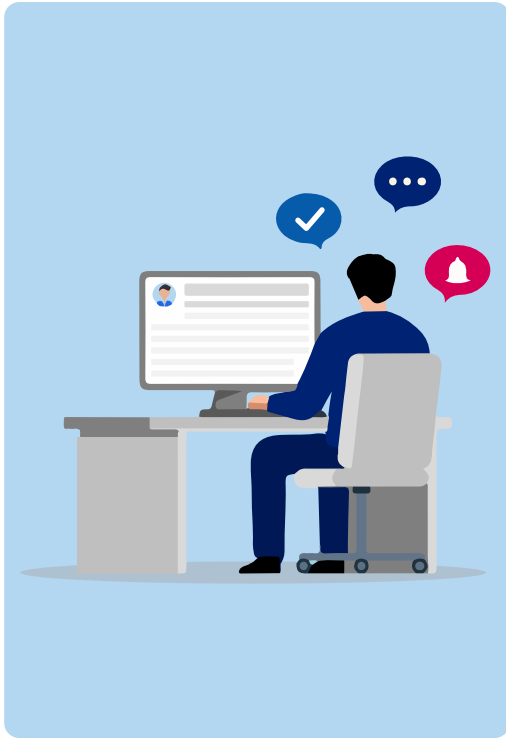
Protocol Review

- ✓ Full Protocol submissions should include all details of the proposed research study to support Regeneron's final evaluation. Submissions must also outline the anticipated study timelines and a publication plan.

With the submission, please include the requested support (drug, funding or both).
For funding support, the budget should be inclusive of Direct, Indirect, per Patient Costs, and Fees.

Incomplete submissions will not be reviewed until all requested information has been received.

Post-Submission Process



1 You will receive an automatic notification confirming that your concept has been submitted successfully.



2 You will be contacted if Regeneron requires further information.



3 The submission will be reviewed, and feedback may be shared at Regeneron's discretion.
